


What was he known for?

"Sárvári Tinódi Grammar School"








Location

It's very close to the town center.








The classes of the grammar school

In Hungarian schools there are 3 ways teachers can evaluate students:

- 1) <u>Verbal test</u>: When the students tell the teacher everything they know about the learned topic
- <u>Pop Quiz</u>: When the teacher tests the students' knowledge by giving tasks they have to complete in a written form
- 3) <u>"End of topic test"</u>: Same as a pop quiz except it's about a whole topic, so it's longer and more difficult. Also unlike in case of short tests, teachers have to tell students about it a week in advance





The school has soccer, basketball, volleyball sports teams






